Lake Anna Residents will Attend Area Boat Shows in the New Year

Whether you're looking to purchase your first boat or trading in your current model, one of the best ways to see the options available on the market is by attending an area boat show. Each show has multiple vendors from around the region who bring in the latest models and sometimes offer great deals for attendees of the boat show.

For 2017, the first one in the area is the Fredericksburg Boat Show, held annually at the Fredericksburg Expo Center. The 2017 show will run from January 20th through January 22nd and tickets are \$8 in advance or \$9 at the door. The next show will be the Richmond Boat Show, held at the Richmond Raceway Complex from February 20th through February 22nd. The ticket price is \$10, while kids 12 and under can enter for free. The show covers nearly 110,000 square feet between four buildings and features boats from 18 dealers.



The 22nd Annual National Capital Boat Show will be held from March 10th through March 12th at the Dulles Expo Center. Featuring hundreds of new boats from dealers throughout Virginia and Maryland, this is one of the region's largest shows. Tickets for this show are \$10 and children 12 and under may enter for free.

The boat show season is an exciting time for those of us at Lake Anna who enjoy spending time on the water, as these displays may offer a special deal or latest model that fits perfectly into our lake needs. The Perm is Back! by Heather Mechler-Fickes

I remember years ago, I dreaded a client coming into the salon to get a curly perm. For me, it meant hours of wrapping hair around little rods, hundreds of end papers, section by section and a long process. Then all of the sudden no one came in to get perms.



Sleek, straight, and flat ironed hair was in, I stashed those bags of perm rods in some boxes and thanked God. Over the last couple of years, I have noticed that perms are making a comeback. The look of a perm depends on the size of the rod and the way the hair is sectioned. More of the pictures of perms in magazines today are loose curls, which means bigger rods are used. If you are aiming for a tight curl-smaller more narrow rods are used. tern that you sectioned the hair and then wrapped the rods for a perm. This was in order to pass the licensing exam. Once I got my cos-

metology license, I realized I could wrap a perm anyway I wanted. This is where creativity can come into play. There are regular perms, spiral perms, piggyback perms, root perms, partial and the list goes on.

All those years, dreading perms, I actually have started to enjoy doing them. I have taken all my perm rods out of hiding and I keep them close with all my other tools. A lot of the time, clients choose to get a perm because they want to add more body to their hair. Perms not only add wave and curl but they can add an abundance of extra volume.

In beauty school, I was taught a specific pat-

Tips for finding your perfect Lake Anna property

This is a tutorial on understanding the very complex Lake Anna Real Estate market. In this article and many more to come, I will explain to the experienced and beginner alike the insights into our market.

One of the most difficult things for a prospective buyer to understand why they see a \$100,000 lot on a website with a beautiful picture of Lake Anna and another for \$700,000 and a very similar picture.

Although there are many things that go into the value of a waterfront lot, the listings that are normally posted on most sites and throughout the listings services do not explain any or many of them.

1) House site view: most realtors or homeowners take pictures of the biggest piece of water they can get to, so the photo you see online may not be the house site view. The house site view is one of the most important things in determining the price of the lot.

For the \$100,000 lot price range, the view from the house site is either bad or non-existent or you are ooking across someone else's property and the view is not guaranteed to be there.

Most of the time, if a waterfront lot is in the \$100,000 range, it is on one of the creeks that merge into Lake Anna at the very north end of the lake. A \$700,000 lot (currently non-existent at Lake Anna), is a premier lot, usually flat with long views at the south end of the lake, where the water is blue and cleaner than on the north end. Right now the Lake Anna market has about 10 premier lots available, but none of them are in this "perfect lot" range. Between the price of \$425,000 and \$600,000 is the range of quality, sought-after lots.

Even though there are slightly over 100 lots on the lake, a high percentage are non-premier, with limited views or even shared wa-

terfront. There are some subdivisions that have 10% of the market inside said divisions, which means finding the lot that fits your budget and your criteria is difficult if not impossible. The sooner one finds a competent real estate broker to represent them, the better.
