





is a Southern rock style with country flavor, which is a bit of a departure for Blount, who has been writing original songs for decades.

"Most of my music is slower, backed by piano or acoustic guitar," said Blount, who wanted to write a song to remind Americans that despite the few things we don't agree on, that we're still neighbors and countrymen. "'United we stand, divided we fall' is an old adage, but no truer words were ever spoken. When I watch television or movies, Southerners are portrayed as less than intelligent, and it seems the goal is to try to divide us. My experience and most of the people I know witness everyone helping each other, cooperating, and treating each other with respect. All types of people with many different kinds of beliefs, working all the time hand-in-hand. We go to church together, work, play, and defend each other on a regular basis."

While Blount enjoys singing, writing and performing, his main goal with the song is to attract a national act that can cover the song and give it a larger audience, to help spread the message.


Blount also created the music video (with 20,000+ views on Facebook in the first month) to showcase the song and message, which is filled with footage from military servicepeople, first responders, and a group that gained national recognition during Hurricane Harvey, The Cajun Navy. Members of the Cajun Navy have also shared this video with their Facebook pages (followed by more than 200,000 people) and have shown their support, even sending Blount a Cajun Navy t-shirt as a thank you for the tribute.

The video shows Blount alongside his daughter, Taylor, and lifelong friend Keith Scott, who is a Marine veteran. "It was very rewarding creating this song because I was able to develop a scratch track with my daughter and friends, take it to the recording studio, and make something I'm really proud of."

Blount is currently hard at work, recording the remainder of his first full-length album, *American Steel*, which will also consist of original songs.

# May Fishing Report Tips and Techniques for Lake Anna

This month usually offers more stable weather than the previous months and allows anglers to catch. fish using many different approaches. At least a third of the fish have spawned and the subsequent spawns will happen within the next few weeks. Some fish will be very aggressive as they are feeding or protecting their beds & fry, while others will be nearly impossible to catch because they are recovering from all of the stresses of laying eggs, fishing pressure, etc.

BASS - Bass spawn at different times during the spring. By the first week or so in May the early big fish spawns are finishing and the early stages of post spawn fishing are revealed. There will still be a couple waves of spawning but the playing field is changing. There will be fish that are thinking about going back to their summer brush piles and ledges but they haven't quite made it out of the "Bass Brothel". These fish will be roaming around on the flats and will get very hungry whenever they recover from the stress of making baby bass. My three favorite baits to find these fish are lipless crankbaits, jerkhaits, and poppers. Spinnerbaits are also a good choice. Since you are looking for transitional fish you are trying to cover a lot of water between the spawning areas and the summer hangouts. Once you get a couple strikes in an area you can slow down and present jigs, worms, or cubes to some of their nearby friends.

STRIPER - Nothing compares to seeing a 35" inch striper crush a 10" shad on the surface, except for casting your super spook right on top of it..twitch..twitch..WHAM!!! On the right morning or late in the evening you can run into some of the most impressive feeding action available in fresh water. This month, big Stripers will begin to transition to main lake areas. They will feed heavily throughout the month on larger baits. If you miss the early morning action you will have to pull out to the deeper flats and channel edges to troll crankbaits, swimbaits and bucktails. If you are equipped with a nice bait well and are proficient at catching bait, you can use free lines, planar boards, and down lines to target Lake Anna Linesiders.

CRappie - Nice size slabs can be found all over the lake. Bridges, docks, brush piles, beaver huts, and grass are home to thousands of Crappie. Many citations have been taken in the last couple of weeks .... One method is to try casting grubs, tubes, and bretle spins as close to whatever cover you are targeting. Another approach is to use a slip bobber above a #6 gold aberdeen hook tipped with a small minnow.

#### Love is in the Air

Understanding the Shad and Herring Spawn

If you have spent any time on the water this time of year you have probably seen large bass in shallow water acting somewhat unusual and staying very localized as they conduct their annual spawning rituals. Sunfish, bluegills, and bream will spawn in large colonies leaving the bottom of the lake covered in pockmarks where they have made their beds. These scenarios create a tremendous advantage for the angler as both of these species, as well as the predators that show up to feed on them and their fry, are preoccupied during all stages of the spawn. In most lakes and rivers, including Lake Anna, the shad and herring spawn is taking place at the same time. If you are able to identify these areas, and the timing is right, you can unlock some of the most productive fishing of the entire year!

WHEN - Typically the bulk of the spawning activity will occur when the water temperature reaches the upper 60's often coinciding with the end of the bass spawn. The shad and herring will not begin actively spawning until well after dark and the bulk of the movement will cease shortly after sun up. Overcast weather or rain may extend this bite. Do not shy away from getting on your spot hours before survise. If you can't drag yourself out of bed early for giant-hungry largemouth and stripers gorging themselves on baitfish - stop reading.

WHERE - You will want to search out areas that are close to deep water but the spawn will take place shallow. Remember that "shallow" and "deep" are relative terms depending on what area of the lake you are fishing. Shad and horning are present throughout Lake Anna so regardless of where you are on the Lake you can identify this pattern. A hard bottom or vertical surface is critical. Riprap, bridge pilings, dock posts both metal and wood, dock floats, and clay banks (especially if a bulkhead or sea wall is present) are all excellent choices.

HOW - The most popular weapon during the shad and herring spawn is the spinner bait equipped with silver or gold willow blades and white or white and chartreuse skirts. Use a trailer hook! This bait is so deadly during the bait spown that anglers are often fooled into throwing all summer long remember past success....don't be that guy. A weightless soft plastic jerk bait (such as Strike King's Caffeine Shad), the bladed swim jig (such as Z-Man's Chatterbait), and a topwater bait (either a buzz bait, walking bait, or popper) will round out your arrenal. When the action is hot you can't get your line in the water fast enough. Once the sun gets up over the treetops it will die off quick. Now down and probe the bottom for a few pity strikes and then wait for tomorrow.


#### 5. Ruffles & Puffy Shoulders
